After yesterday's media exposure of the woman who dumped a cat in a wheelie bin, the Ledbury Portal can reveal a spate of copycat animal binnings.

The animal welfare group T.I.G.G.E.R. was contacted about this animal cruelty and were keen to see the Ledbury Portal footage.
