Taking advantage of the 'silly season', Bovis Homes has put in a revised planning application ( 192482

) for land east of the 'Barratt' site, ie. south of the bypass and further towards the Gloucester Road. The closing date for representations is next Thursday, 22nd August.

The major differences between this one and its predecessor ( <u>174745</u> , which was <u>withdrawn</u> in July 2018) are a reduction from 185 dwellings to 140 and yet another roundabout on the bypass.
