

Emergency Active Travel Measures in Ledbury - Update

Following a '[consultation](#)', Herefordshire Council has now decided which measures will be implemented in Ledbury. These are:

- An overall 20mph speed limit throughout the town;
- The south-east end (narrow bit) of Woodleigh Road will become one-way to motor traffic.

This will give space for a contraflow route for cyclists and a footpath for pedestrians.

Work to implement these measures will commence on or after 20th July.

Update: in fact nothing happened until mid-September.
