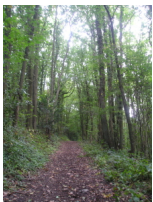

### **An autumnal walk in Crews Hill Wood Nature Reserve just north of the Malvern Hills between the wooded Suckley Hills and the hilltops above the Teme Valley.**

Worcestershire Wildlife Trust describe the walk amongst three nature reserves as a wildlife and landscape trail. Buzzards call and fly overhead, grey squirrels dart about and interesting fungal growths sprout from trees.

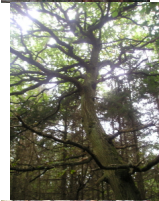
