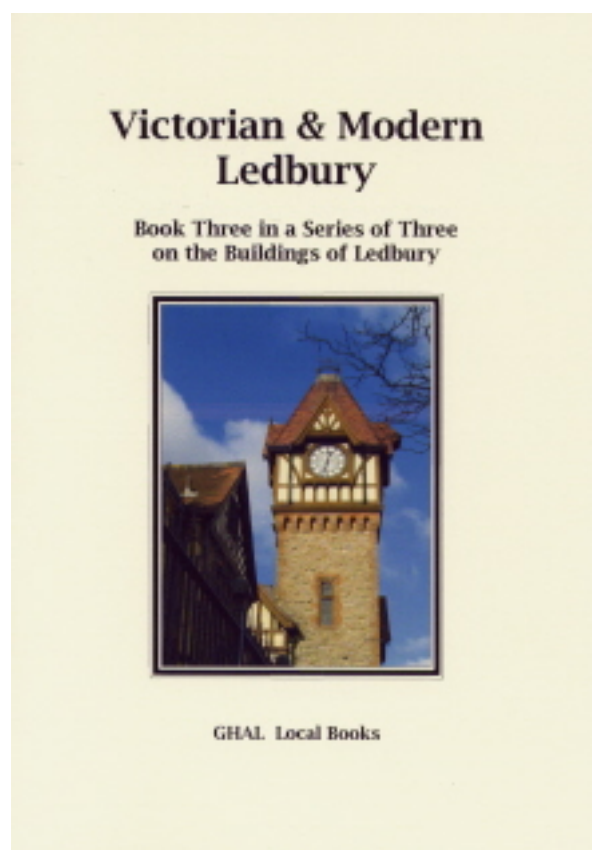

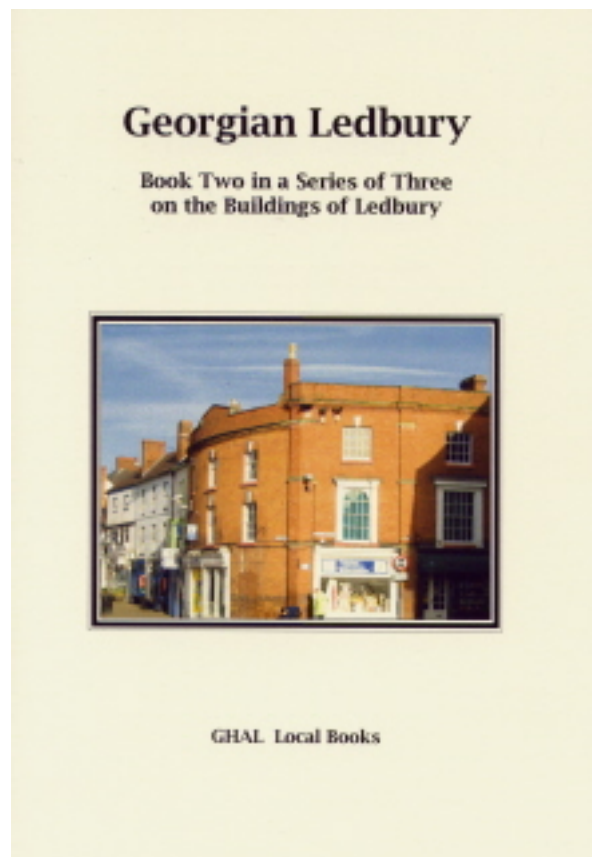
The distinctive buildings of Ledbury are well illustrated in three new guide books from local publisher GHAL (Geography, History, Art & Literature) Productions;

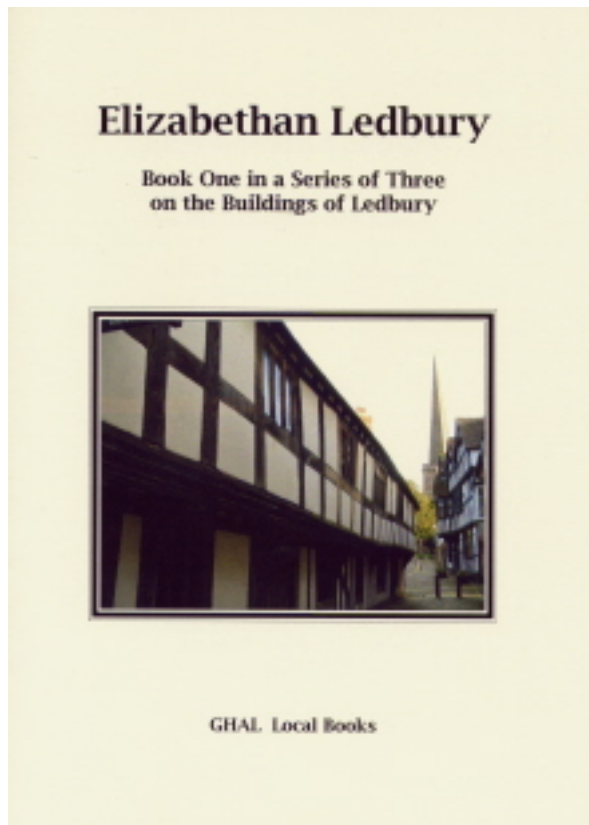
